







## Shape Fishing - How to Play

- For this game you will need to make a fishing rod. I like to find a small twig or you can use a piece of dowel.
- Tie a piece of string or ribbon on to one end of the stick and attach a magnet to the end of the string.
- Print 2 copies of each card and laminate them. To help your game last longer you could print on to card or glue your 2 copies onto card before you laminate it. There are 3 cards given for this game. The children can take turns “fishing” or you can print out enough copies for more children.
- Cut out all the shapes from one copy of each card.
- Attach a paper clip to each shape and the children can go fishing. When they catch a shape they need to find the shape on the uncut board.
- Continue until all shapes are covered.

The pieces of this game can also be used for a lotto game or a memory game.
